About the role

Objectives

This role is focused on the successful delivery and adoption of technical solutions and services across Sense. This role will focus on delivering our Digital Social Care Records system as the first of many projects, which will be focused on delivering Software-as-a-Service solutions to replace legacy applications and improve organisational efficiency. This role is responsible for delivering new technology solutions and major upgrades to existing services. Success in this role includes user adoption of technology solutions across the organisation to deliver the organisational benefits of these new solutions.

On a day-to-day basis this involves working with business teams and our suppliers to deliver a portfolio of changes from concept to delivery. This role is predominantly focused on the application tier, however it will be essential to work across the internal technology and data teams, and new and existing suppliers to ensure data and systems integration for a seamless user experience.

The role will matrix manage a variety of people as required for each project, and will be be responsible for bringing these people together, leading the project delivery teams. The project manager will manage project reporting and governance, working closely with the project board members and project sponsor. The encombant will be expected to contribute to the Sense project management approach, helping to develop the PMO function and processes and mentoring individuals across the organisation.

Key responsibilities

- Manage projects from concept to delivery, using a variety of project delivery methodologies and techniques.
- Manage project governance and reporting for allocated projects
- Delivery of new technology solutions and services, and major upgrades to existing systems, working with internal and external data and tech teams



- Manage Implementation of new solutions and systems, including user adoption, business process change, testing, training and communications.
- Supply chain management
 - Supplier selection and procurement
 - Manage delivery of projects through suppliers
- Manage transition to business-as-usual activities, complying with change control and release management processes and ensuring appropriate documentation and handover are delivered as part of the project.
- Deliver projects to agreed time, cost and quality, managing project budgets and resources efficiently
- Maximise the benefits achieved from technology investment, ensuring appropriate benefits measurements and monitoring are implemented.

- Strong and pragmatic Project Delivery, including use of agile and waterfall approaches.

- Proactive and collaborative approach to managing risks and issues and developing project plans.
- A champion for the user, committed to making the user experience inclusive and as straightforward as possible
